Successful Christmas dinner wraps up 2010

What eats 400 pounds of turkey and 100 pounds of ham and still has room for a table full of sweets?

That would be your crowd attending the 2010 Intergroup Christmas Open House and Potluck dinner at St. Mark's Anglican Church in Marda Loop in mid-December.

The 2010 Christmas dinner was one of the most successful in recent years with between 400 to 450 AA members, families and guests attending the annual event.

"It was great day weather-wise and the hall remained full as soon as the doors were open at 11 a.m.," says Keith M. outgoing Intergroup Special Events Committee chair.

With seating for about 90 people at any one time, there were periods of standing-room-only during the day as members and guests dropped in for the buffet-style dinner. Special Events Committee member Wayne, even made arrangements for Santa to make a special appearance during the afternoon.

A dedicated kitchen crew started slicing meat, mashing potatoes and preparing trays of contributed food at 10 a.m. and didn't stop until the last plate was dished up just before 3 p.m. At last count some 19 turkeys and 16 hams were served, along with between 200 and 300 pounds of potatoes, 25 bags of coleslaw, gallons of gravy, stuffing, vegetables, other side dishes and desserts. Twice during the dinner runners made trips to pick up extra meal supplies as the hungry crowd remained steady.

"It was a great opportunity for some of the oldest members of AA as well as some of the newest to join together in the fellowship of the program and the season," says Keith M.

While most food is contributed, there are related expenses required in putting on the annual dinner. With cash contributions from several groups and a very generous 7th Tradition collection, the event netted just more than \$1,800, after expenses, that will be used to help support the operation and programs of Calgary Intergroup. The 7th Tradition collection that day itself raised \$1,475.

"Our special events are about fellowship and not about making money," says Keith M. "But, it is always nice when you can have a great event, pay your expenses and still have funds left that can help further in carrying the message of the program to others."

Along with the cash contributions from home groups, Keith M. also recognized the service work of many AA individuals and groups who helped with set up, worked in preparing and serving food during the day, and stayed for the all-important clean-up at the end.

"It was a day that demonstrated the strength of the fellowship and the importance of the unity of the AA program," says Keith M.

In November, Keith M. passed the Special Events Committee files over to new chair, Jan K. who will be organizing events for 2011.
