INTERGROUP ELECTIONS NOVEMBER 12, 2012

The annual Elections for the chair positions on the Calgary Intergroup body will be held at the Intergroup Meeting November 12, 2012.

Calgary Intergroup is the main body representing all AA groups in Calgary and area, and is responsible for the operation and services provided by the Central Service Office in Calgary. Individual AA home groups name a representative to Intergroup and the collective Calgary Intergroup elects individuals to serve as chairpersons in various areas of responsibility

The Intergroup Chairperson and It is those positions that will be elected at the November meeting.

Currently all intergroup chair positions are elected for a one year term. The chair and vice chair must rotate after one year. All other chair positions can be re-elected for a second one year term.

The following positions will be elected on November 12, 2012

Chair: Responsible for ensuring Business operations of Central office are carried accurately the financial obligations of Central Office and Intergroup are satisfied. Chair Is responsible for chairing the Steering Committee and Intergroup Body meetings.

Vice Chair: carrying out duties of Chairperson, if absent; Prepared to become chairperson at conclusion of current Chairperson Term; May coordinate Intergroup Worships as required

Treasurer: Ensures accurate records are kept; ensures financial guidelines are followed. Oversee preparation of monthly financial statements for review.

Secretary: Recording minutes of all regular and special meetings of the Steering committee and Intergroup body

Monitoring Chair: Responsible for arranging for groups to monitor phone lines, maintain the 12 Step list; assemble and distribute monitoring packages; assist monitors if necessary

Public Information: Responsible to contact people or groups inquiring to determine specific information requested i.e.: speakers, type of audience etc. Maintain an up to date list of speakers at schools etc. Co-operate with Intergroup Chairperson on matters relating to PI and CPC.

Sunday Morning Breakfast: Maintain a list and ensure an AA group hosts the Sunday Morning Breakfast.

Collect money for meals, 7th Tradition and ensure financial obligations are met. Keep accurate record of attendance and finances and report to Steering Committee monthly.

Westword Editor: Responsible for producing the monthly Intergroup Newsletter using guidelines approved at the Intergroup meeting. Assembles all information submitted for printing, verifying information as needed. Announces any special insert information at monthly Steering Committee and Intergroup Body meetings.

Liaison to CGSC: Attends all Calgary General Service Committee meetings (last Monday of each month at St. Marks) as the Intergroup Body representative. Reports on the activities and function of the CGSC at Steering Committee and Intergroup Body meetings.

Archives: Establishes and Advisory committee particularly relevant to all historical data, records and artifacts received. Has Calgary and Area archives display available at Calgary Central Office and for local activities: Roundups etc.



We are expanding and do need help from people who are interested in helping the professional help us.


We are currently influencing young Doctors and Nurses at both Universities and will soon be doing presentations for the Social Work faculties.
